## July Meeting Minutes

That we submit SK Water's lagoon proposal to the Lakeside RV Trailer Park and ask if they will give us a commitment of whether they are in favor of financially participating in a regional lagoon. We agreed to construct the road system for the Lakeside R.V. Trailer Park Phase II development and bill them for costs.

That the nuisance grounds be available to "residents" of the RM of Loreburn only.

The administrator shall attend the workshops as follows: Rural Municipal Financial Statement Workshop, Tax Enforcement Workshop and MEPP training sessions in October.

That tax arrears equal to or less than ½ of the previous year's levy shall be deleted from the List of Land in Arrears and owners whose land is on the List shall have 30 days to pay the arrears before the List shall be advertised in the paper.

We will donate \$500.00 to the Village of Elbow's July 1<sup>st</sup> fireworks display.

We have no intention of widening road allowances affected by the construction of new power lines to service the Danielson Provincial Park.

## July Meeting Highlights cont.

We approved the proposed subdivision of the NW 15-25-04 W3 and the SW 22-25-04 W3 as the subdivision complies with our Zoning Bylaw.

We agree to send a letter to Premier Wall supporting the reduction or elimination of the education tax on property.

The council agrees to purchase a gas whipper sniper for the RM office/shop area.

## August Meeting Highlights

We contact SK Water, the Village of Elbow and the Resort Village of Mistusinne and request an additional 90 days to review the regional lagoon proposal.

That we amend our New Deals Funding application to include a Shop Energy Upgrade.

That we amend our projects under the MEEP to include the following projects: Rock incorporation on various spots, Road reconstruction of E 11-27-06; E 14 & 23-26-04; W 30 & 31-28-05 W3; and stripping at the gravel pit.

That we charge ratepayers having their lanes maintained at a rate of \$50.00.

That the 2 inch pit run gravel stockpiled at the nuisance grounds is for our municipal roads only and is not for sale.

Officers were appointed to act at the 2010 municipal election. October 29<sup>th</sup> from 5.00 – 7.00 p.m. was set for the advance poll.

The Reeve signed the Road Haul Agreement stipulating the speed limit on the haul road be reduced to 60 km and that the road would be watered if it becomes too dusty.

That we apply for construction funding for 4 miles of the Clearing the Path road W of Section 36 & 25-27-05 W3 and S of Section 1-27-05 and Section 6-27-04 W3.

## September Meeting Highlights

We entered a contract with Loraas Disposal to lease a 30 yard recycle bin to recycle cardboard and it shall be placed at the nuisance grounds.

That we contact the Village of Strongfield and let them know that we cannot accept their trees, steel and appliances at our nuisance grounds.

That we contact March Consulting to act as an outside broker to an approach to a wastewater solution for our municipality's developers.

All employees will be enrolled in the SARM Short Term Disability Program for 2011 with the employees paying half of the premiums, this being taken off of each pay cheque.

## September Meeting Minutes (cont.)

That we increase all the fire grants to the Villages by an additional \$300.00.

That the Administrator be allowed to attend the RMAA District meeting in Rosthern on September 22, 2010.

That we appoint Kevin Vollmer, Brian Brown, Garry Book and Darryl Norrish to a committee to purchase a Cat Dozer trailer. The budget amount for this expenditure will be \$25,000.00.
